The legislator requires every organization where people are employed to determine, by means of a risk analysis, what measures should be taken to provide an effective first aid policy.

Depending on the activities and the number of employees within an organization, it is necessary to have one or more first aid company first responders trained. The content of this basic training is as follow:

- Emergency approach
- Unconscious victim and stable side position
- CPR AED
- Counselling victim after trauma
- Specific care skills for an eye injury, insect bite, splinter and tick bite
- Contents of the first aid kit and dressing techniques
- **Evacuation techniques**
- Application of first aid for: skin wounds, burns, bleeding, shock, life-threatening and non-lifethreatening situations, head and spinal injuries, disorders of the musculoskeletal system, poisoning.
